





Unemployment by Gender









Labor Force Participation Rate Trends




Unemployment Rate Trends

Napa County, CA had a January 2024 unemployment rate of 4.64%, increasing from 2.89% 5 years before.






Millennials

Napa County, CA has 24,743 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 27,308.


















Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Occupation Employment Concentration






